## Scholarship holder selection minute

### Preamble

This selection of a scholarship holder refers to the call for a MSc degree holder under the project " FIBRE composite manufacturing technologies FOR the automation and modular construction in shipYARDS", which ran from November 2nd to November 17th 2021 with the reference RH FYBER4YARD 33/2021.

**Work Plan title:** Evaluation and selection of FRP connection technologies for shipbuilding implementation

In accordance with the FCT regulations for the allocation of Research Grants, the announcement was posted in the regular locations: INEGI and Euraxess and other educational institutions. A jury was also formed, composed of the following PhDs: Doutora Ana Queirós (President), Professor Doutor Lucas da Silva (Vowel), Doutor Eduardo Marques (Vowel); Doutor Ricardo Carbas (Vowel).

### Minute of the November 22 2021, meeting

The Principal Investigator of the project presented the curricula of the grant candidates, namely:

The evaluation of the candidates was based on the aspects presented in items 4 and 9 of the announcement: the academic curricula and their adequacy to the proposed work were analysed. Taking into account the selection criteria and the documents presented, the jury believes that the candidates Carlos Eduardo Lino, do not meet the intended requirements since he doesn't present MSc degree in Mechanical Engineering or Aerospace Engineering with final grade equal to or higher than 15 values, The candidates Vasuki Rajakumaran, Sasan Karimi, Seyedahmad Taghizadeh, Sajad Jangravi, Pooyan Vahidi Pashaki do not meet the intended requirements, since they do not present proof of academic degree recognised by a Portuguese Institution.

Based on the curricular evaluation, the jury decided the following classification (0-100), corresponding to the arithmetic weighted average of each member's marks.

- Fatemeh Delzendehrooy (97/100)

In conclusion, in the opinion of the jury and with nothing to object, Fatemeh Delzendehrooy was unanimously selected for the scholarship.
